Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of Universal Remote Control.

Universal Remote allows you to replace a broken or lost remote or to combine more than one remote into one.

This remote control operates the common features of most but not all models and brands of IR Infrared Controlled Video Equipment.

This remote may provide functions that are not available on your equipment. For example, menu operations, some function of your particular equipment may not be controlled by this remote in such cases use the original remote control for your equipment.

Please use this manual to become familiar with your Universal Remote.

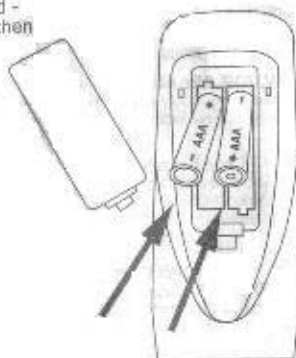
After you are familiar with your remote the first thing you need to do is to add batteries and program your remote to your particular product and brand. See table of contents above.

Thank you for buying a remote and we hope it will give you many years of service.

Battery Installation

Your Universal Remote requires two new AAA alkaline batteries. To install the batteries:

1. On the back of the remote, push down on the tab and lift the cover off.
2. Match the batteries to the + and - marks inside the battery case, then insert the batteries.
2. Press the battery cover back into place.



Battery Saver

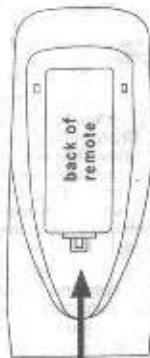
Your remote will automatically "time-out" if the keys are depressed more than two minutes. This will save your batteries should your remote get stuck in a place where the keys remain depressed (e.g., Between the sofa cushions).

Code Saver (Important)

You will have no more than 90 seconds to change the batteries in your remote without losing codes you have programmed. However, **do not** press any buttons until batteries are secured in the remote. If buttons are pressed without batteries in the remote, **all codes will be lost.**

Glow Keys

Must be exposed to bright light before the keys will glow in the dark. The longer the exposure to light the longer the glow. Do not place in Direct Sunlight. Natural day light or light from a Filament lamp or fluorescent lamp is sufficient to recharge the glow material.



Button Functions

Some buttons on the remote control might have functions that are referred to by different names on your product. For example "Prev. Ch." may be called "RECALL" or "ENTER" may be called "DISPLAY." These differences depend on the brand and model of your product. Also, this remote can only operate features that exist on your product. For example, your product must be equipped with "Prev. Ch." ability for the "Prev. Ch." button to operate this feature.

Indicator Light
The indicator lights when any button is pressed.

TV, VCR, CBL/AUX
Selects product to be operated.

Code Search
Used to program the remote or to search through codes.

CHANNEL Up/Down (Arrows)
Change channels.

NUMBERS
Enter numbers for direct channel selection. Some products require "Enter" to be pressed after channel selection.

ENTER
Shows the TV's Channel/Time display. May also be used after direct channel number entry to immediately change to the selected channel.

MENU
Access the Menu functions of the device you are controlling.

SELECT/ADJUST
Used to select and adjust menu items of the device you are controlling.

Note: The REC button must be pressed TWICE to record from your VCR. For brand VCRs, press the REC button once, then press it again for three seconds.



POWER
Turns product On or Off.

VOLUME Left/Right (Arrows)
Changes the volume level of the product, normally the TV.

MUTE
Turns off the TV sound while the picture remains.

Prev Ch
Returns to the previously selected channel.

TV-VCR/Sources
For some TVs, press repeatedly to select from available viewing sources (antenna, cable box, VCR, etc.)

QUIT
Used to exit menu functions.

RECORD, PLAY, STOP, REWIND, FFWD, PAUSE
VCR control buttons operate your VCR even when the remote is set to operate the TV.

Programming Your TV

1. Manually turn on the TV.
2. Press and hold the CODE SEARCH button until the Indicator Light lights, then release the CODE SEARCH button.
3. Press and release the TV button (the Indicator Light will blink and then remain lit).
4. Find the three digit code for your TV in the code list in this booklet and enter it using the Number Buttons.

Programming Your VCR

1. Manually turn on the VCR.
2. Press and hold the CODE SEARCH button until the indicator Light lights; then release the CODE SEARCH button.
3. Press and release the VCR button (the Indicator Light will blink and then remain lit)
4. Find the three digit code for your VCR in the code list in this booklet and enter it using the Number Buttons.

After your code is entered, the indicator will turn off.

Note: If the LED blinked rapidly when you entered the code you may have entered invalid code. Recheck the code list and try again.

5. With your VCR on, press CHANNEL Up. If the VCR responds, no further programming is required.

Note: If some buttons do not operate your equipment, try one of the other codes for your brand.

6. Enter your code here for easy reference.

Note: The REC button must be pressed TWICE to record from your VCR. For brand VCRs, press the REC button once, then press it again for three seconds.

Programming Your BOX

1. Manually turn on the Cable Box.
2. Press and hold the CODE SEARCH button until the Indicator Light lights; then release the CODE SEARCH button.
3. Press and release the CBL button (the Indicator Light will blink and then remain lit).
4. Find the three digit code for your Cable box in the code list in this booklet and enter it using the Number Buttons.

After your code is entered, the Indicator will turn off.

Note: If the LED blinked rapidly when you entered the code you may have entered a invalid code. Recheck the code list and try again.

5. With your Cable Box on, press CHANNEL Up. If the Box responds, no further programming is required.

Note: If some buttons do not operate your equipment, try one of the other codes for your brand.

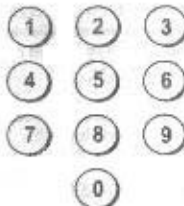

Auxiliary Programming

Aux button allows you program a CD, secretary and TV, or VCR

1. Manually turn on the device you wish to program.
2. Press and hold the CODE SEARCH button until the Indicator Light lights, then release the CODE SEARCH button.
3. Press and release the Aux button (the Indicator Light will blink and then remain lit).
4. Find the three digit code for your device in the code list in this booklet and enter it using the Number Buttons.

After your code is entered, the Indicator will turn off.

Note: If the LED blinked rapidly when you entered the code you may have entered invalid code. Recheck the code list and try again.

5. With your device on, press CHANNEL Up. If the Box responds, no further programming is required.

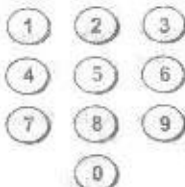

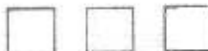


Programming with Code Search

If your code for your TV, VCR, Cable Box or CD Player is not listed, try the following procedure to find the code for your device.

1. Manually turn on the device you wish to program.
2. Press and hold the CODE SEARCH button until the Indicator Light turns on, then release the CODE SEARCH button.
3. Press TV, VCR, CBL or AUX (depending on which device you wish to program). The Indicator Light will blink again then remain lit.
4. Press the POWER button until the device shuts off, this may take up to 300 tries. (If you skip over a code, press CHANNEL DOWN to back up).
5. Press MUTE to complete setup.
6. After you found your code through code search identify your code number for future use.

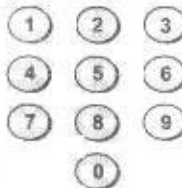
Code Identification

1. Press and hold CODE SEARCH until Indicator light turns on. Release CODE SEARCH button.
2. Press and release desired Mode button (TV, VCR, CBL, AUX). Indicator light will blink once to indicate key-press acceptance.
3. Press and release the CODE SEARCH button, indicator Light will blink off to indicate key-press acceptance.
4. To find the first digit press the numeric keys from 0 to 9, when the Indicator Light blinks off, this is the first stored digit. repeat to find the second digit.
5. To find the third digit, repeat step four. This time the Indicator Light will remain off once the key corresponding to the third digit is pressed.
6. Enter the code number on the proper page.

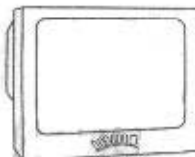

Indicator light blinks after you program a product code.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remote did not accept the code. • Try to program the code again or try a different code.

Product Operation
